Good evening, It's a pleasure to share recent highlights and upcoming events from our community in my City Manager report.

Last week, we took time to recognize Public Service Recognition Week by honoring the dedicated public servants who help keep Cupertino running. Last Thursday, residents and City employees also participated in the annual Bike to Work Day.

Earlier this month, Mayor Chao held her Monthly Chat at Lee's Sandwiches in St. Joseph's Plaza. These gatherings occur on the second Tuesday of each month and offer residents and businesses an opportunity to discuss various topics directly with the Mayor and City staff.
