6/15	C6	Theft by False Pretenses	On 6/15, unknown suspect(s) sent a message to the victim's computer, claimed the victim's bank account was at risk of being hacked, and instructed the victim to wire money in order to secure the account. The victim also gave the suspect(s) access to the victim's cryptocurrency account, where funds were stolen. The total loss was valued at about \$38,000. The victim lives in Cupertino.
6/15	C3	Injury Collision	Occurred at 5:26 PM at Homestead Road and S. Mary Avenue.
6/16	C3	Possession/Transportation of Controlled Substance for Sales, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia ARREST	At 1:03 AM, deputies stopped a motorist at Stevens Creek Boulevard and Mary Avenue for an equipment violation. An investigation revealed a passenger in the vehicle was in possession of Methamphetamine for sales, in addition to drug paraphernalia. The suspect passenger was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
6/16	C5	Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision	Occurred at 2:18 PM at Apple Park Way and N. Tantau Avenue.
6/16	C4	Attempted Grand Theft	At 6:25 PM, two unknown suspects installed fake cash doors to two ATMs at Wells Fargo bank on N. De Anza Boulevard. Two victims attempted to withdraw \$1,000 each, were unable to retrieve their money, contacted police after noticing duct tape on the cash doors, and eventually retrieved their money.
