6/29	C2	Vehicle Tampering	Between 9:44 PM on 6/27 and 8:00 AM on 6/28, unknown suspect(s) tampered with a vehicle parked in the 10000 block of Stokes Avenue and stole both the front and rear license plates for an unknown loss.
