The suspect bicyclist refused to identify himself and an investigation revealed he was in possession of someone else's passport, in violation of the suspect's probation terms. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.

1/4	C4	Possession of Stolen Vehicle, Petty Theft with Priors, Misappropriation of Lost Property, False Impersonation and Identification to Peace Officer ARREST	At 8:59 PM, deputies responded to an automated license plate reader notification for a stolen vehicle at S. De Anza Boulevard and Bollinger Road. An investigation revealed the vehicle was stolen in San Jose and was still outstanding. Deputies located and stopped the vehicle a short time later, and further investigation revealed the suspect driver was in possession of driver's licenses and credit cards not belonging to the suspect, in addition to tools that appeared to have been stolen from Home Depot. The suspect also provided false identifying information and impersonated someone else to avoid detection of two outstanding warrants. The suspect was arrested and booked into Main Jail.
