1/26	C3	Residential Burglary, Theft by Credit Card	Between 12/1/25 and 12/16/25, two suspects stole a credit card from a residence in the 20000 block of Forge Way and made fraudulent purchases totaling approximately \$1,655. The suspects are known and at large.
