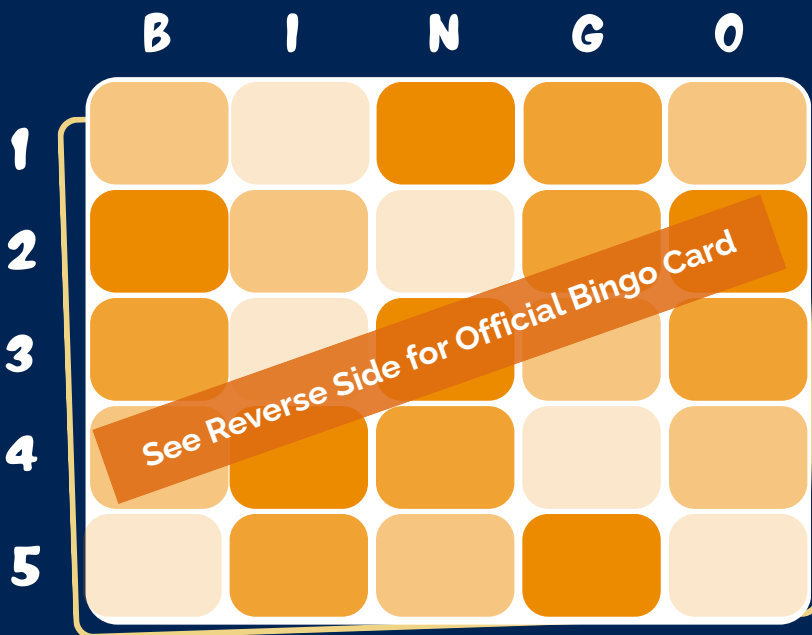

Instructions:

2. Have fun doing the walk and roll-related activities **on the back of this page**. Answer the question in each square to show you completed the activity.
3. When you complete 5 squares in a row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) you have a bingo!
4. When you complete the entire board, you have a blackout!
5. Turn in your card to the Children's Desk of the Cupertino Library by 6:30 p.m. on May 31st. Bingo prizes can be picked up when cards are turned in. The blackout prize raffle will be conducted the first week of June and winners will be contacted at the email address written on the back of this card. Write clearly!
